

JOURNEY MIDDLE SCHOOL CONSENT AND WAIVER FORM

For Child Participating In Moderate Risk Activity: SWIMMING EXPLORATORY Term 1: October – December, 2022

This term Journey Middle School will be offering my child, _____, an opportunity to participate in a Swimming exploratory that is off campus. Students begin on Thursday, October 20, 2022 and ending in December, 2022. I waive any and all claims I may have against, and release from all liability and agree not to sue, The Board of Trustees of School District No. 62 and its officers, employees, agents, volunteers and representatives, and the Ministry of Education for any personal injury, death, property damage or loss sustained as a result of my child's participation in the field trip, arising out of any cause whatsoever, including negligence. There is a fee of \$14 which will cover all 7 days of Swimming at Sooke Seaparc.

I hereby give my consent, and acknowledge by my signature that: Students will walk to and use the Sooke Seaparc pool and will be away from the school from 1:15 to 2:50. The students will be supervised by Mr. Vine and Mrs. Walker (or a teacher-on-call if necessary) and Seaparc lifeguards and staff. It must be understood that the nature of the activity is such that your child may not necessarily be within a staff member's sight at all times.

I am aware of the usual risks and dangers inherent in participation in all of the activities associated with this exploratory, and of the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage or loss resulting from the activities. The possibility that your child may not heed safety instructions or restrictions given to the group.

I will supply suitable swimwear and clothing for my child's participation in all activities associated with the exploratory with an understanding that apparel may be wet and muddy and a dry change of clothes may be needed. My child and I understand that it is our responsibility to ensure my child has all necessary swimwear and clothing. My child and I understand that the school's Code of Conduct applies during this exploratory. I will be responsible for any costs caused by my child's failure to abide by the Code of Conduct, including any costs to send my child home.

Accidents can be the result of the nature of the activity and can occur with or without any fault on either the part of the student, or the school board or its employees or agents, or the facility where the activity is taking place. By allowing my son/daughter to participate in this activity, I am accepting the risk of an accident occurring, and agree that this activity, as described above, is suitable for my child.
