Support Sweeps- In creating a positive climate and school culture for learning. JMS will be incorporating support sweeps throughout the school year. Frequent tardiness to class on a daily basis can create learning gaps in student learning if they are not able to grasp the learning goals presented during lessons. The first four to eight minutes of class can be unproductive if students straggle in, disrupting instruction and students and the class lose valuable instructional time. When students are unsupervised in hallways and restrooms after the warning bell rings—whether at the beginning of school or during passing periods for F.A.S.T—there is ample opportunity for vandalism, bullying, and other forms of misconduct. This misbehavior can and always carries over into the classroom, thus wasting even more instructional time to get students focused on the lesson at hand.
