If you do not have access to the internet, please contact the school and we can help you through this process manually. As a reminder, on this day students will have early dismissal at 11:58pm in advance of the interviews.

## School Affordability Act- Earlier this year, the Provincial Government created a Student and Family

**Affordability** *Fund* to support families in financial need during these times of increasing costs of living. Through this fund, JMS has been provided resources to improve food security and assist parents, guardians, and students with the reduction or elimination of school related costs. Our intention is to provide these funds in a way that is flexible, private and as stigma free as possible.

JMS, in consultation with our Parent Advisory Council (PAC) and School Leadership Team (composed of Administration and Teachers), discussed ways to help families who are facing financial hardship. We've decided to provide gift cards to assist in purchasing items such as food, clothing and/or public transportation, we will also distribute holiday baskets, revamp or breakfast and lunch program, create a school closet that offers apparel, hygiene kits etc. We can also help with school related costs such as field trips and school based extra-curricular activities.


