


Dear JMS Families,

Living Life to the Full - Free Mental Health Course for B.C. Youth-Living Life to the Full is a mental health promotion course designed to help people deal with everyday life challenges and learn self-management skills using Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT) principles. It's an interactive 8-week course, where participants learn how to reduce stress, worry, and boost mood; improve motivation and problem-solving skills; and change unhelpful thoughts and behaviours.
