

YOUR CONSENT

Annual Consent Required
Schools must check every year whether your child will access Indigenous programs and services.



All students with Indigenous ancestry will receive programming unless you opt out.



If you do not want your child to participate, contact the school before September 29, 2025.

With gratitude and respect, we acknowledge that we live, learn, and work on the traditional territories of the Coast Salish: T'Sou-ke Nation, SCÍΛNEW (Beecher Bay) Nation, and the Nuu-chah-nulth: Paaʔčiidʔath (Pacheedaht) Nation. 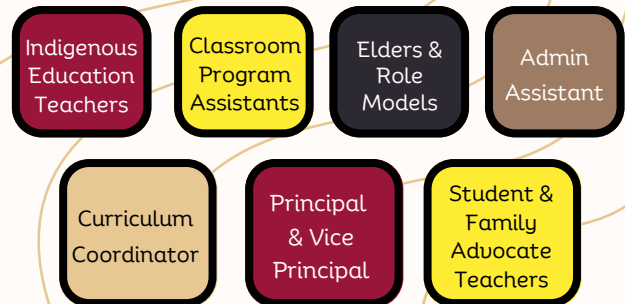
